Target audience

Secondary geography teachers interested in running their own Olympics field trip

Overview

This course will help you find out about the geographical context of the 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games and show you the key places to carry out fieldwork based on this major world event.

The day will start on the edge of the Olympic Park in Stratford, after which venues such as the Olympic stadium, the athletes' village, the broadcasting centre and the multi-sports arena will be viewed. Participants will also visit Holden Point, the area's best vantage point, which gives an amazing panoramic view of the entire park and has been used by the International Olympic Committee to review progress.

The course will also spend time looking at the potential impacts of 2012 on Stratford, including new developments such as the Westfield Centre, which opens in September 2011. These will be considered within a sustainability framework and ideas of how this might be assessed in the field will be given.

Aims and outcomes

- To update your subject knowledge of the London 2012 Olympics and their impacts.
- To consider strategies for fieldwork in the area.
- To consider broader criteria by which the London 2012 Olympics might be assessed, such as regeneration and sustainability.
