## Target audience

Secondary geography teachers involved in the delivery of controlled assessment

## Overview

This course will discuss the relevance and application of new technologies, including accessible GIS, to support and enhance the delivery of controlled assessment for all GCSE specifications. There will be a focus on strategies for developing visualisation and free web-based technologies to display field data and research findings. There will also be a discussion on the role and relevance of some new alternative and mobile technologies to complement controlled assessment.

Delegates will leave with a pack of useful materials and some 'homework'. Ongoing support will be provided via a blog.

## Aims and outcomes

- To update knowledge of latest web-based GIS resources and thinking in secondary geography.
- To raise awareness of how visualisation and GIS materials can be used in teaching and controlled assessments, especially for the presentation of collected data.
- To become more confident with the potential uses (and pitfalls) of the technology.
- To meet with other colleagues and develop points of contact for ongoing support.
