Rules

What your film is about: Your film must be on one of the following themes:

Length of your film: Your film must last no longer than 60 seconds including titles and end credits.

Submission of your film: Your film must **arrive** at The Geography Department, Langtree School, Woodcote, Reading, Berkshire, RG8 0RA **no later than February the 14th 2008**. It must be submitted on mini-dv or as a high quality AVI file on a DVD along with a completed submission form.

Permissions: Make sure that you have permission to include everyone who you have filmed. It is important that you ask them for permission and that they sign a release form. If they are 16 or under their parents will also have to sign a release form. An example of a release form can be found at www.geography.org.uk/annualconference/filmfestival

Working with others: You can work with as many people as you like.

Copyright: Please do not use any copyright material (including music, maps and photographs) that you do not have permission from the copyright holder to use. To be on the safe side, it is best to only material that you have created yourself. We know this is very annoying, but we do not have the capacity to check that you're keeping it all legal.

Number of entries: One entry per person only please.

Keeping it clean: Your film will be watched by young children so it must be suitable for 'pre watershed broadcast'. This means no strong language, violence, scenes of a sexual nature or distressing scenes.

No strobes please: Do not use very quick cutting or strobe lighting in your film as this can affect people with epilepsy.

Learning about our world: The purpose of the festival is to give people the opportunity to learn something new about our world. In keeping with this aim, films that are submitted to the competition are likely to be reproduced and published for use by students and teachers in schools and universities either online or through any other available media. If you submit a film you agree to it being published in this way.

Winners: Will be informed shortly after the 14th of February and will have the chance to buy tickets before they go on sale to the general public.

Prizes: All prizes will be awarded at the film festival.
