



CHANGING PLACES

Purpose of the teaching & learning pack

Initial consultation with schools in Castleford identified a number of things that schools felt would support their work with pupils on the regeneration of the town. One of the items most frequently mentioned was a 'resource' pack that they could share with their pupils/ students. While some schools wanted resources electronically others clearly wanted hard copies of available materials. A compromise had to be struck because of cost – all schools have received examples of the architects designs and drawings as A4 colour copies and also with additional examples on a CD-Rom.

In addition to the architect's plans, the pack contains ideas for teaching and learning.
