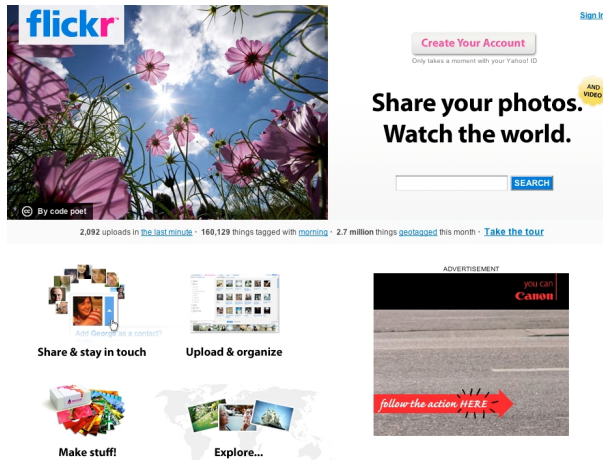


A Guide to using Flickr



The Flickr home page. It's not necessary to log in to use the site. A Flickr account is almost essential for geography teachers and is required if you wish to upload, comment and add notes to pictures.

Searching Flickr:

All photos on the Internet are copyright and none can be reused without the permission of the photographer. Some people allow their work to be freely reused by attaching permission called 'creative commons'.

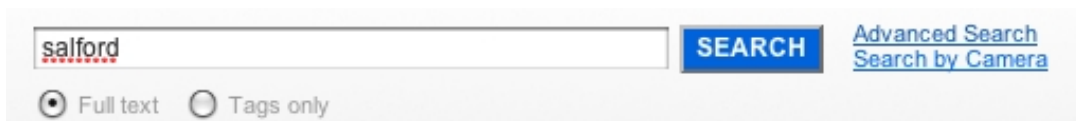

Explain to the students that they can only use creative commons images in their work. To search for cc images, use Flickr's advanced search option:

1. Enter the search term and click 'search'



2. Click 'Advanced Search'



3. On the next page, scroll down to the creative commons options

Tags are the descriptive words added by photographers that make it much easier to search Flickr.
