Olympic Performance Index 1=divide medal points tally by total population. \*Rank countries from highest to lowest to get alternative medals table. For example, the Bahamas with 7.14 is ranked number 1 and will appear at the top of the 'alternative' medals table followed by Cuba and Jamaica.

Olympic Performance Index 2=divide medal points tally by GDP per capita PPP US\$ 1996. Rank countries from highest to lowest to get alternative medals table. N.B. you may wish to divide GDP per capita by 1000 to get a more manageable figure with which to make the calculations. For example, 29194 becomes 29.194 (USA), 7107 becomes 7.107 (Russia) and so on.
