Olympic Performance Index 2=divide medal points tally by GDP per capita PPP US\$ 2000. Rank countries from highest to lowest to get alternative medals table. N.B. you may wish to divide GDP per capita by 1000 to get a more manageable figure with which to make the calculations. For example, 34142 becomes 34.142 (USA), 8377 becomes 8.377 (Russia) and so on.
